Beginner Mandarin Lesson Plan

Name: Tian Xiao Grade(s): Grade 10

Subject(s): Mandarin Modality: Online Synchronous

Duration: 45 minutes

Enduring Understanding(s)/Big Idea(s):

- Understanding Chinese culture and traditions through festivals and celebrations.

- Ability to communicate basic grocery shopping and food ordering in Mandarin.
- Mastery of writing basic Chinese characters related to topic festivals, grocery shopping, ordering food.
- Understanding the importance of cultural awareness and cross-cultural communication.

Equity/ Diversity and Social Justice (Teacher Actions)

- Incorporate a variety of learning materials that represent diverse perspectives and experiences.
- Create a classroom environment that is inclusive and respectful of all students.
- Provide additional support for students who struggle with language or cultural barriers.
- Use closed captioning or digital tools for different learning needs or abilities.

Materials:

- Computer with internet access.
- Zoom or other video conferencing platform.
- Online Chinese characters writing resources.
- Use a digital whiteboard to demonstrate writing Chinese characters
- Use a learning management system (LMS) to assign and collect homework
- Use online guiz tools to administer guizzes and provide instant feedback
- Educational technology: <u>LingoHut, Zoom, Google Classroom, Youtube, Archchinese</u>.

Lesson Plan

I. Introduction (5 minutes)

- Welcome students and introduce the topic
- Share learning objectives for the class review section: Communication terms about festivals, grocery shopping and ordering food.

II. Review and Collecting/Answering Questions/ Assignments & Assignments Feedback (10 minutes)

- Review material from previous classes: <u>LingoHut</u>
- Collect questions on Google Classroom discussion page and answer the questions.

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III. Writing Chinese Characters (20 minutes)

- Teach students to write some basic Chinese characters related to the topic: Archchinese
- Provide feedback and correction on students' writing

NOTE: Students can preferably use tablets and electronic pens to practice writing exercises. It is difficult to practice Chinese characters using a mouse, and it is difficult for teachers to give accurate comments on writing Chinese characters using pen and paper in online meetings.

IV. Quiz (10 minutes)

Administer a guiz on the material covered in this week's class: Google Classroom - Quiz 4
